Martha Lee Hines of Bloomington, Indiana died at Bloomington Hospital surrounded by her family on January 30, 2011 at the age of 54. Martha was born with Down Syndrome at the University of Iowa Hospital in Iowa City, Iowa. She was the daughter of H.F. Tim Hines and Mary Ann Kroll Hines. She is survived by her father Tim Hines, Bloomington; brother Kevin Hines (Dee), Evansville; sisters Rebecca Philippsen (Greg), Bloomington; Sarah Smith (David) and Jennifer Pierce (John), Indianapolis; 16 nieces and nephews; 18 great nieces and nephews; and a host of extended family and friends who will cherish the memory of her wonderful personality. She was recently preceded in death by her mother, Mary Ann Hines. Martha was a resident of Miller House, a group home operated by Stonebelt Center in Bloomington, Indiana.
