



Martha "Marcie" Tichenor

May 5, 1944 - November 17, 2009

Marcie Tichenor, beloved wife, loving mother, devoted grandmother and cherished friend, was lifted up on Tuesday evening with family by her side. Born in Ironton, Ohio on May 5, 1944 and raised in Louisville, Kentucky, Marcie made Bloomington her home for 47 years.

Survivors include husband, Ray, children, Tim (Terri) Tichenor, Jon (Marta) Tichenor and Beth (Kevin) Theile all of Bloomington and 8 grandchildren (Tyler, Taylor, Tessa, Bailey and Griffin Tichenor and Kendall, Madison and Regan Theile). Marcie's brother Donald Berg of Detroit, MI also survives her. She was preceded in death by her parents, Carl and Anita Berg and her brother, David Berg.

Marcie retired from T.I.S. Group in 2004, where she served as co-owner and Vice President for 30 years. She was a longtime member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church. Philanthropically, she supported numerous organizations including: St. Mark's, Indiana University School of Music and IU Athletics. More recently, Marcie was a passionate supporter of Bloomington Hospital's Children's Therapy Clinic.
