



Martha "Lorelle" Sarchet

November 20, 1930 - August 31, 2024

Martha "Lorelle" Sarchet, 93, died peacefully on August 31 at home with her family at her side. She was born at home on November 20, 1930, in Cambridge, OH, the daughter of Emmett and Lura Williams. She was preceded in death by her husband of 44 years, Max Sarchet, in 1995. After graduating from Cambridge High School in 1948, she attended Cambridge Business College. Then she worked at March Electric Co. Ironically, Lorelle and Max were working at Kingston Conley Co. when friends who were dating introduced them to each other. They were married on December 23, 1950, at St. John's Episcopal Church.

Our mother was the heart and soul of our family. Mom was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. One of her greatest joys was music; she played the piano by ear her entire life and listened to diverse music. She adored the color yellow, which matched her sunny personality, and loved all lemon desserts. Mother delighted interacting with her family, children, and animals. The family moved to Bloomington in 1965 when Max transferred jobs with RCA—trading small-town life for the big city! Mom had recently obtained her driver's license, earning the title of family chauffeur, adding to her domain of expertise (top chef, child educator, laundry services). For the first 18 years after her children were born, she worked strictly as the CEO of the Sarchet household. Mother was a car-pool driver, den mother, and PTA member through the years. Once all the children were in school, she worked part-time at Hatch's IGA and Kmart East. She retired from Bloomington

Hospital after 20 years of providing patient care as a nursing assistant. Mother was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church and attended Northside Christian Church following the death of her husband.

Her six children survive her: Richard Sarchet (Linda), Connie Krier (George), Christine Combs, David Sarchet, Beth Sarchet (Doug O'Mullane), and Melissa Gilliland.
