



## Marvant Mark Duhon

July 5, 1950 - May 31, 2023

Marvant Mark Duhon, passed away on May 31, 2023, at the age of 72. Marvant grew up in a large family in Lake Charles, Louisiana. He believed strongly in the importance of family and in his roles as husband, father, and Paw Paw.

Marvant attended Cornell University, where he met his wife, Susan. Following graduation, he joined the Marines, and served, among other places, in the Vietnam War, mostly during the evacuations. After returning home after the war, Marvant and Susan settled in Bloomington, Indiana. He spent most of his career as a nurse, focused in home health care, and he loved his patients like family. He also enjoyed being active in local politics. Since retirement, Marvant's greatest joy was spending time with his grandchildren.

Marvant is survived by his wife, Susan, and his siblings: Ferris Duhon (Ruta), David Duhon (Laurie Shaffer), Kathy Duhon (Bruce Squiers), Kevil Duhon (Kathy Crown), Pierre Duhon (Paula), and Sylvia Duhon (Robin McCormick), as well as Brad's widow, Melinda Olds. He is also survived by his three children and four grandchildren: Russell Duhon (Chang Liu), Julie Duhon (Tom Mathai, with children Abigail, Antony, and Eleanor), and Kendra Bauer (Jace, with son, Miles).

Marvant was preceded in death by his parents, Elton and Melda Duhon, and

his brothers, Rusty Duhon and Brad Duhon.
