Mary King LeMay Baxter, 83, of Bloomington passed away peacefully Friday, July 27, 2012 at the Brown County Health and Living Community in Nashville, Indiana. Born October 30, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Julia (Mooney) and Kenneth King.

Mary was a lifelong resident of Bloomington and a graduate of Indiana University, where she was a member of Kappa Alpha Theta sorority. Mary's mother established The King's Shop, a fine woman's clothing boutique in Bloomington, in 1946. Mary worked in The King's Shop alongside her mother, and eventually became the proprietor until 1995, at which time the business closed. After her retirement, she enjoyed gardening and cooking and was always happiest surrounded by family and friends.
