Mary Josephine Halloran Otto, age 97, of Bloomington, passed away Wednesday morning, June 13, 2018, at the Indiana University Hospital Health Hospice House. She was born October 13, 1920 in Indianapolis, Indiana to Irish immigrant parents, Thomas Halloran and Catherine Griffin Halloran. After graduation from St. John's Academy in Indianapolis, Mary went on to work at Diamond Chain during World War II and later at Aetna Life Insurance, first as a switchboard operator and then as a receptionist. She was a long-time member of St Charles Borromeo Catholic Church where she was active in a card club and the Retiree Club. Mary took great pride in being married for 66 years to Frank V. Otto, an Indianapolis Police Department Lieutenant, who predeceased her in 2008.

Mary is most remembered by her kind and gentle manner and total devotion to her loving family. She treasured family dinners, vacations, and holiday celebrations, especially decorating the Christmas tree each year with treasured ornaments.
