Mavis Cloud Siebenthal, 95, of Bloomington, passed away Thursday, April 23, 2015 at the IU Health Hospice House in Bloomington, Indiana. Born March 26, 1920, in Neosho Missouri, she was the daughter of Eleanor and Thomas Cloud; she had three brothers and two sisters.

She married Robert L. Siebenthal of Bloomington on November 11, 1944 in San Francisco, California and soon moved to Bloomington, where they raised their three daughters.

Mavis was a longtime member of Bloomington's First Christian Church, where she was an active volunteer. She also volunteered for the Psi Ote Thrift Shop, was a volunteer and donor for Red Cross Blood Drives, and delivered for Meals-on-Wheels. She was a long-standing member of Psi Ote Xi Social Sorority, the Unique Club, and the Conversation Club.

She is survived by her two daughters Judith Garrison of Savannah, Ga and Tracy Siebenthal of Bloomington; brother Charles Cloud of Chattanooga, Tennessee; six grandchildren Robert Burks, Ellen Garrison, Kent Garrison, Ruby

Garrison, Corinne Henry and Keith Reynolds; and one great-granddaughter Mahalia Mavis Henry.

Mavis was predeceased by her husband of 65 years, Bob (2008), and their daughter Janet Burks (1971).

A memorial service will be held 1pm Monday, April 27, 2015 at Allen Funeral Home with Rev. Helen Hempfling officiating. Burial will follow at Valhalla Memory Gardens. The family will receive friends from 2-7 p.m. Sunday and 12-1p.m. Monday at the funeral home.
