



Michael Fedorchak

October 20, 1923 - October 16, 2009

Longtime Bloomington resident Michael Fedorchak, 85, died Friday, Oct. 16, 2009, at Meadowood Health Pavilion. Born Oct. 20, 1923, in Olyphant, Pa., he was the son of William and Anna (Pish) Fedorchak. On April 29, 1950, he married Margaret (Veselosky) Fedorchak, who survives in Bloomington. An Otis Elevator retiree, Michael worked in Harrison, N.J., from 1959-65 and in Bloomington from 1965-1991. He previously worked for General Electric in Bloomfield, N.J. A Navy veteran of World War II, he served in Seabees Unit 501 in the South Pacific. Michael was a member of St. Charles Catholic Church, where he served as an usher. He was also a member of the American Legion. An avid sports fan, he golfed, bowled and loved his Red Sox. He was a former president of the Otis bowling league and previously coached the company's baseball team. He also played the violin in several orchestras. In addition to his wife, Margaret, survivors include his son and daughter-in-law, Paul and Judy Fedorchak, Greenfield; grandchildren, Emily, Steven and Paige Fedorchak, all of Greenfield; and his sister-in-law, Anna Veselosky, Bloomington. He is also survived by a brother, Walter Schurko, Dunmore, Pa.; sister, Anna Chekansky, Scranton, Pa.; and Michael was preceded in death by his parents; a son Michael Edward Fedorchak and sisters, Helen Nagurney and Marie Fedorchak; and brothers, William Fedorchak and Andrew Scurko.
