Nancy Louise Fee, 92, of Bloomington, passed away on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at IU Health Bloomington Hospital. She was born on October 31, 1930, in Goshen, Indiana; the daughter of Joseph Franklin and Alberta (Yoder) Wysong.

Nancy was a Delta Gamma and graduate of Indiana University. A longtime resident of Bloomington, she was a dedicated volunteer to her community.
