



## Nancy Moss

August 24, 1935 - December 11, 2012

Nancy Fields Moss, 77, of Bloomington passed away Tuesday at the IU Health Hospice House. She was born on August 24, 1935 in Dugger, Indiana the daughter of James and Violet (Boswell) Fields. Nancy graduated from Bedford High School class of 1953 and received a Bachelor Degree from Indiana University. Nancy retired on June 30, 2001 after 18 years as the Administrative Assistant in the Philosophy Department at Indiana University. She was an avid IU fan and very loyal to the university. In honor of their fathers James M. Fields and Anthony J. Moss, the former of whom attended IU and performed with the Singing Hoosiers with Hoagy Carmichael, Nancy and Bud in 1998 established the James M. Fields and Anthony J. Moss Fellowship. Once the fellowship is active, it will support a graduate student in Philosophy concentrating in either ethics or history of philosophy. Nancy was a member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church and a previous member of the First Christian Church in Bedford. Nancy is survived by her loving husband of 17 years Clemens "Bud" Moss; 4 sister-in-laws Lillian Sperka, Marie Bugajski, Joan Bednarz and Celine Moss; one brother-in-law John Krull; a cousin Jo Ann George and her sons John, James and Donald, and caregiver Kay Bennett. She was preceded in death by her parents and 2 sister-in-laws Virginia Krull and Rita Kiester. A Funeral Mass will be held 11 a.m. Tuesday, December 18, 2012 at St. Charles

Borromeo Catholic Church with Father Thomas Kovatch officiating. Entombment will take place Wednesday at the Holy Cross Cemetery in Calumet City, Illinois. Family will receive friends from 4-8 p.m. Monday at Allen Funeral Home. A memorial service will be held at a later date in Illinois.
