Naomi Margie Wahl, age 97 of Bloomington, passed away Tuesday morning, March 11, 2014 at her residence. She was born in Bloomington to Ellis and Amy Owens Frame on December 8, 1916. Naomi graduated from Bloomington High School and attended Indiana University briefly. During World War II she worked at RCA as a Navy Inspector of torpedo guidance systems. She went on to own Bloomington Janitor Supply, Laundry and Apartments with her husband Clarence.

She attended Fairview United Methodist Church and was a member of the Victory Class and United Methodist Women.

Naomi is survived by one son, James Wahl of Bloomington; three grandsons, Joseph Wahl , Jr. of Mississippi, Jordan and Justin Wahl of Indianapolis; one great grandson Joseph Wahl III of Mississippi; and one brother Gilbert Frame.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Clarence in 1992, one son Joseph Wahl Jr. in 1972, and a brother, Chester Frame in 1995.
