



Ned M. Tudor

July 28, 1922 - April 19, 2015

Ned Tudor, age 92 of Bloomington passed away Sunday afternoon, April 19, 2015 at Monroe Hospital. He was born in Howard County on July 28, 1922, to Paul Tudor and Pearl Miller Tudor.

He graduated from Gaston High School in 1940, and immediately enlisted in the United States Navy. He served in the Pacific Theatre aboard the ammunition supply ship USS Procyon as it's store keeper supplying various other ships in the region. Upon his return to state side he married Wilma Doris Fallis in 1947, and went to work for the family owned grocery stores in Muncie, Indiana. After the sale of the family grocery stores Ned went to work for the Marsh Grocery Stores, where he worked for 35 years, before retiring in 1984. He was a former member of the Lions Club of Frankfort, Indiana and the Rotary Club in Bloomington, and was a man of deep faith in God.

Ned is survived by his wife Wilma Doris Tudor of Bloomington; son Thomas G. Tudor and his wife Susan of Lapel, Indiana; son Philip Lee Tudor of Pompano Beach, Florida; grandchildren Eliza Tudor-Sykes and her husband Lance, Adam Tudor and his wife Dawn and Chris Tudor and wife Sarah, as well as six great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, sister Janet Ellison, and

brothers Jack, C.B., Ray and John Tudor.
