Norma Faye Pope, 73, of Bloomington, Indiana, passed away May 3, 2017, at 4:42 p.m. at IU Health Bloomington Hospital. Norma was born July 7, 1943 in Anderson, Indiana to Oscar Gerald Hawkins and Helen Louise (Cazee) Johnston.

She was a lifelong artist who studied fine art at Indiana University. As part of her studies at IU, she spent three wonderful months living and studying at a Navajo Reservation in Arizona. Her favorite mediums were oil, watercolor, and pastel. She most often painted landscape scenes that were reminiscent of her youth spent on farms in rural southern Indiana. She was a resident artist at Billie Creek Village in Rockville, Indiana for over ten years and her paintings are privately owned in over fifteen different countries. Norma owned art galleries in Nashville and Ellettsville, Indiana, and she greatly enjoyed teaching art to her children, grandchildren, and many private students. Norma and her husband, Roy, loved time with family, nature, books, long drives in the country, and cross-country car trips with their children and grandchildren. Her family wishes to thank her, and Roy, for showing them how beautiful and full life can be.

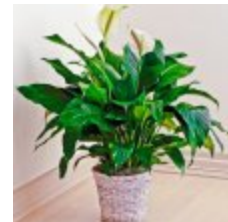

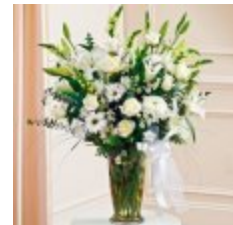
