Norval Edmund Maguire, 92, of Bloomington, passed away Tuesday at his residence with his family by his side. Norval was born on November 14, 1921 in Pitcairn, PA; he was the son of Royal "Roy" and Bertha (Beurleycamp) Maguire.

Norval was an attendee of the University of Pittsburg and Indiana University. He served in the United States Navy Sea Bees during WWII. Norval was present during the raising of the United States of America flag on Mt Suribachi, Iwo Jima. Norval loved golf, traveling, camping, reading, woodworking and was a long standing member of the free masons.
