Opal Yvonne Harden, aged 84, passed away peacefully on April 2, 2023, surrounded by her family after losing her long battle with metastatic breast cancer. her grandkids in all their endeavors whether it be academic, artistic or athletic. If you asked her to come, you could count on finding her white hair in the crowd cheering you on. In addition to events, she was always the center of family celebrations and holidays. We had been planning our annual Easter egg hunt in her big yard, it will not be the same without her.

In addition to her immediate family, Opal made sure to stay connected to her siblings, nieces, nephews, cousins, classmates and community. She organized the family reunions, Mauder Christmas dinner and of course, made the best noodles and sweet potatoes at both. She was a member of the Southern Hills Church of Christ and former member of the North Central Church of Christ. She was a member of the local book club Judging Covers and enjoyed the opportunity to read books she would never choose herself. Opal also volunteered as a site host for Habitat for Humanity's Women's Build, proudly wearing her "Grandma Opal" nametag.

We would be remiss to not mention Opal's love of IU basketball and Kansas City Chiefs football. She had fun stories of celebrating in town when IU won the NCAA championships and always rooted against Purdue. During her last year of treatments, watching sports gave her a needed escape and these teams were her favorites.
