Opal Pauline (Hoover) Hutts, 85, of Bloomington, passed away on Saturday, July 29, 2017, at her residence. She was born on January 22, 1932 in Kingman, Indiana, the daughter of John Franklin and Sarah Anna (Clift) Hoover.

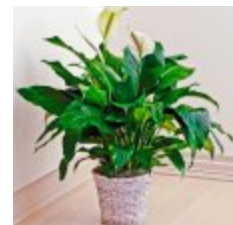
