



Patricia A. (Pat) Moore

January 9, 1934 - August 1, 2013

Patricia A. (Pat) Moore, 79 of Bloomington, IN passed away August 1, 2013 at Meadowood Health Pavilion in Bloomington, IN. She was born in Kansas City Missouri on January 9, 1934, the daughter of Leslie and Catherine Hix. She received her BA degree from Mount Saint Scholastica College, Atchison, Kansas in 1955. She married John C. Moore and lived most of her married life in Hempstead, Long Island, N.Y. where her husband was a professor of history at Hofstra University. She received her M.A. in Education from Hofstra University in 1974. She was the mother of four children--one son, and three daughters.

Pat was active in her parish of Our Lady of Loretto, Hempstead NY, serving as religious education teacher for several years and as assistant director of the program for four years. She was a leader of song at weekend liturgies and parish vocalist for weddings and funerals for several years. She also served as lector and Eucharistic minister.

Pat taught third grade at St. Thomas School in West Hempstead for one year and did substitute teaching at St. Thomas and at Our Lady of Loretto.

In 1998, she retired with her husband to Bloomington, Indiana, where she was a parishioner of St. Paul Catholic Center. She is survived by her husband, John C. Moore; her four children, John, Jr. of Trinity FL, Joan Vanore of Indianapolis, IN, Carolyn Moore of Sedona AZ, Mary Vukelich of Mechanicsburg PA; and six grandchildren. She is also survived by sisters, Margaret Miller of Kansas City, Mo., and Sister Patricia Marie Hix, C.S.J. of Cut Bank MT.
