



## Paul Leroy Mattoon

September 4, 1934 - August 4, 2015

Paul Leroy Mattoon, 80, of Bloomington Indiana passed away Tuesday morning at the Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. Paul was born on September 4, 1934 in Moose Lake, Minnesota; he was the son of Roy and Selma (Mathison) Mattoon.

Paul, a veteran, served in the United States Army during the Korean conflict as jungle warfare instructor in Panama, Central America.

After his honorable discharge from the Army, Paul attended college at the University of New Mexico where he met and married his loving wife of 61 years Barbara (McCurry). He graduated with a BS in Industrial Engineering.

Paul held engineering and senior management jobs with Kennecott Copper Company, Kaiser Aluminum, Kaiser Refractories and numerous consulting positions after retiring from Kaiser. Throughout his career he and his family traveled the country and the world including 3 years resident in Ghana, West Africa where he served as the Chief Production Superintendent at Kaiser's Volta Aluminum plant.

A loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather he is survived by his wife Barbara, his son Mark Mattoon and his daughters Michele Mattoon and Sheryl Kasbaum.
