Paul Whitney Swain Jr., 71, of Bloomington, IN, passed away on April 12th, 2026.

He was born October 29th, 1954 in Washington, D.C. to Paul Whitney Swain Sr. and Addie Lee Swain (née Dupree). After graduating from St. Anselm's Abbey School in D.C. in 1972, he moved to Bloomington to attend Indiana University where he studied English and Law, ultimately earning his Juris Doctor. After being admitted to the Indiana State Bar he went on to practice law in Bloomington until his passing. Paul had the distinct honor of being the first African American elected to the Bloomington City Council and proudly served as a Member at Large from 1992 to 1995. Paul was a music aficionado, an avid musician, and enjoyed playing guitar in a multitude of bands over the years. He also enjoyed good arguments, good books, trivia, and playing golf.

He is survived by his son, Paul Whitney Swain III (Naomi) of Ellensburg, WA; grandchildren, Adara and Micaiah; and siblings, Valerie Swain of Washington, D.C. and Mark Swain of Washington, D.C. He was preceded in death by his parents, Paul Whitney Swain Sr. and Addie Lee Swain. A celebration of life for Paul will be held at Allen Funeral Home, 4155 S Old State Rd 37, Bloomington, IN on Sunday April 19th, 2026 from 2 pm until 4 pm. A memorial service will be held at the funeral home during this time at 2:45 pm. A
