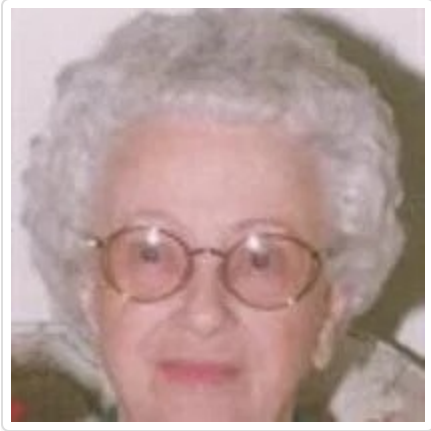




Pauline Frances Archer
