Peggy Andrews, 85, passed from God's Earthly Life into God's Eternal Heavenly Life at I.U. Hospice House on Wednesday, April 3, 2024 at 1:10am. Peggy was the oldest of five children born to Cedrick and Frances (Medley) Walden, June 10, 1938.

Peggy graduated from Stinesville High School, class of 1956, she immediately began employment at Sarkes Tarzian, she also worked at Bloomington Laundry, Monroe County United Ministry, and her main job was at the I.U. Union Building Bakery.

At I.U., she met and married Charles Robert "Bob" Andrews. They exchanged wedding vows, December 27, 1973 at the Stinesville United Methodist Church. Peggy and Bob celebrated a wonderful life together until his sudden heart attack death on September 1, 1994. Bob was a night custodian at I.U. Jordan Hall.

Peggy was a member of Stinesville Christian Church and later, Olivet Christian Church, and for a time, served as church song leader.

Peggy and sibling, Janice (Walden) Shuler Basham, during junior/senior high school days, often sang duets at various Christian churches throughout Monroe County and the surrounding area.

Peggy and sibling, Lowell (Mary) was an important helper/worker to move Peggy into her apartment six years ago.

Peggy and sibling, Patrick, have lived in next door apartments for six years. Since Peggy's stroke in January 2023, Patrick has lived mostly with Peggy and been her 24/7 caregiver.

Peggy and youngest sibling, Tawana (Walden) White Nicholson (Norm) as Tawana lived with Peggy and Bob during her four year tenure as an I.U. student. She was very much a part of their family and home.

Peggy has many nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews, and even some great-greats.

Private burial will be held at Rose Hill Cemetery-- Allen Funeral Home Assisting.
