Philip Dean Lewis, 71, of Bloomington, passed away suddenly Wednesday evening at the IU Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born on September 24, 1941 in Bedford, IN, the son of Emmett and Phyllis (Hawkins) Lewis. Philip graduated from Bedford High School and attended Indiana University with focused attention on the medical field. He was with Bloomington Hospital for nearly 40 years, becoming the Director of Radiology in 1975. During his 26 years as Director, Phil oversaw three major additions to the Radiology department, the latest of which is what you will experience as a patient at IU Health Bloomington Hospital today. Phil retired in 2001. Phil was an Elder and Church Trustee for the First Christian Church, Bloomington, Indiana. He loved spending time with his family and had special times with his grandchildren. He made great memories traveling the world and enjoyed fishing and watching IU and Butler Basketball.
