Phillip Eugene Hedrick, 86, of Bloomington, died Friday, July 24, 2009 at Garden Villa in Bloomington. He was born on December 18, 1922 in Bloomington the son of Heston and Clavis (Stewart) Hedrick. He was employed with Indiana University for 23 years and also worked for Harris Tin Shop and Woodward Heating.
