



Richard Keenan

February 3, 1932 - March 16, 2012

Richard (Dick) Keenan died Friday, March 16th at Methodist Hospital due to complications following heart surgery. Dick was born in Clearfield, PA on February 3, 1932, the son of Sarah Edna and John Paul Keenan. Dick attended Lock Haven State Teachers College, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Penn State University and the U.S. Navy Post Graduate School in Monterey, CA; he studied math, physics, electrical and industrial engineering and management. Dick served for 22 years as an officer in the Navy, retiring in 1975 as a Commander. His last tour of duty was at Crane Naval Ammunition Depot in Crane, Indiana. After retiring from the Navy, Dick was a teacher and Business Manager at Culver Military Academy in Culver, Indiana. He then moved to industry, working at Ares Engineering Co. in Port Clinton, Ohio, followed by ARCO Solar in Camarillo, California. Dick and his wife, Fran loved Indiana, so they returned when Dick took a job with Vitro, Inc. and then Comarco, where he was Vice President before retiring. Dick would continue to teach at Ivy Tech in Bloomington after retirement. Dick is survived by his wife of 54 years, Fran, his brother Curt (wife Marcella) and his children: Dr. Wynter Vik (husband Dr. Terry Vik), Dr. Heather Keenan, Rich Keenan (wife Clarissa), and Paul Keenan (wife

Candice); five grandchildren Stuart, Nathan and Sara Vik, Katie Keenan, and Mackenzie Keenan. A memorial gathering will take place on Saturday, March 24th at Allen Funeral Home from 1pm to 3pm.
