Robert E. Craig, 91, of Bloomington, passed away on Monday, March 30, 2020 at Stonecroft Health Pavilion. He was born on July 1, 1928 in Nortonville, Kansas; the son of Boyd and Viola (Dunn) Craig.

Robert graduated from Bloomington High School and later went on to study at Indiana University and Butler University. Robert was the President of the Craig Agency where he worked in sales.
