Robert "Bob" "Ferg" E. Ferguson, age 78, of Bloomington passed away on Thursday, May 30, 2024 after a year of being ill leaving behind his family and dog Skamp.

Bob was born on February 24, 1946 to Lena Lucille (Quillen) Williams and William Ralph Ferguson. He played basketball for 3 years and graduated from Bloomington High School in 1964. He enlisted in the Air Force on September 29, 1965. Bob married his high school sweetheart on March 10, 1966, he and Anna had been married for 58 years. In September of 1966 Bob was sent to Republic of Vietnam where he served at Korat Royal AFB, Thailand as an Airborne Radio Operator.

Bob was a truck driver for most of his life. He worked for Wetterau, numerous trucking companies, and retired from USF Holland in 2002 where he served as Union Steward. He also held many part-time jobs. His final position was with Bloomington Public Transit as a bus driver which he left in May 2023.

Bob was a member of the American Legion Burton Woolery Post 18. He loved gathering with friends and family for dinner, drinks, and laughter. He was a huge sprint car fan, loved camping and working in his yard.

Bob is survived by his beloved wife Anna; his daughter Lori Jacoby (Gary), his son Robert Brian Ferguson; grandson Nicholas Brewer; granddaughter Miranda Brewer; stepson Jayleb Jacoby and partner Abby; brother Rick Ferguson; two sisters Joyce Nichols and Rebecca Ferguson; and many nieces and nephews.
