Robert Grimm Conklin, 80, of Bloomington passed away Friday July 9, 2010 at the Bloomington Hospital. He was born in Yonkers, New York on January 17, 1930 to William Wood Conklin and Mary C. Grimm Conklin, the third of three sons. He was baptized and made confirmation at St. John's Episcopal Church in Yonkers.
