Robert Anthony Hannon, age 68 of Bloomington passed away Friday, November 13, 2020 at the Golden Living Center. Bob was born at Porter Memorial Hospital in Valparaiso, Indiana on June 2, 1952, the seventh and last child of James and Margaret Hannon.

Bob attended St. Paul's Grammar School in Valparaiso, Indiana, and is a 1970 graduate of Valparaiso High School. During his high school years, Bob was on the football and wrestling teams. In the years following high school, Bob worked a variety of jobs in the construction trades and played bass guitar in a number of bands. In his adult years, Bob faced many challenges due to health issues. All who knew him also knew his friendly nature and his ability to adjust to life's challenges.

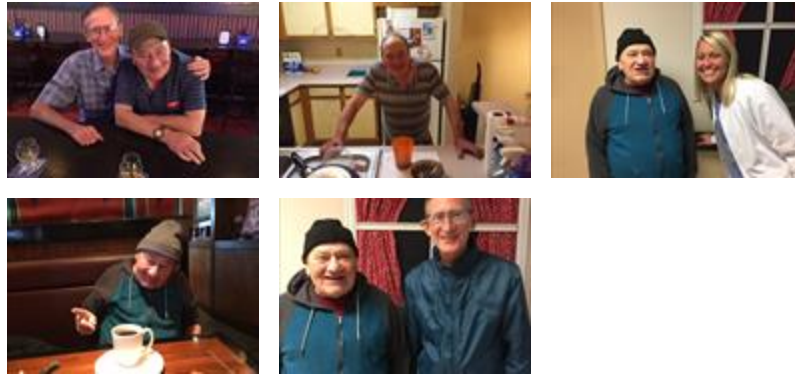
“ Bob loved to write to his siblings and others. His letters were sometimes clear and easy to understand... and sometimes not. This is from a note Bob sent on a large index card.
