



## Robert H. Haas

Robert H. Haas, 90, of Bloomington, passed away Tuesday at Garden Villa in Bloomington. Robert was born on March 8, 1924 in Madison, Indiana; he was the son of Charles Edward and Bessie (Cain) Haas. At the age of six Robert moved to Cleveland, OH after the death of his mother to live with his aunt and remained there until 1982.

Robert was a United States Navy WWII veteran serving from 1942-1946. He was a Merchant Marine in the Atlantic War Zone from 1942-1944. Robert was a member of the American Legion. His hobbies included gardening and woodworking. Robert was a Boy Scout Leader for several years receiving recognition and awards for his service.

After Robert was discharged from the Navy he owned a printing company and then worked in the printing industry for Bedford Lithographs and various companies in the Cleveland, OH area, Moore Langen Printing and Publishing in Terre Haute, IN and retired in 1992 from Color Dot Graphics based in St. Louis, MO.
