Robert J. DuMay, 64 of Bloomington, IN passed away November 21, 2012 at IU Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born May 20, 1948 in Gary, IN to Robert and Bernice (Brehoski) DuMay. Robert graduated in 1967 from Lew Wallace High School in Gary, IN.

He was in the U.S. Marine Corps and a Veteran of the Vietnam War where he received the National Defense Service Medal; Vietnamese Service Medal with three (3) stars, Vietnamese Campaign Medal with (60-) device, Vietnamese Meritorious Unit Commendation Medal with palm, and Rifle Sharpshooter Badge.
