



## Robert "Bobby Joe" Vaught

May 24, 1932 - January 1, 2010

Robert "Bobby Joe" Vaught, age 78 of Bloomington, passed away Monday November 1, 2010 at the Monroe Hospital. Bobby Joe was born May 24, 1932 in Sanders, Indiana to Jackson and Agantha Deckard Vaught. He spent his professional career in the stone masonry and brick laying industry firstly working with various co-owners and eventually with his son, Wayne. Bobby Joe was a past Business Agent with the local Bricklayers Union where he, family and friends were an important part of the stone work for Indiana University, High Schools and local business's. He was also a member of Sanders Pentecostal Church, a member of the Monroe County Saddle Club, a member of the Elks Lodge in Bloomington, and a member of the American Quarter Horse Association. He served his country proudly in the United States Navy from August of 1950 until June of 1954.
