Robert L. Medaris, age 78 of Bloomington passed away June 3, 2014 at the Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born March 8, 1936 in Spencer, Indiana to Ralph and Jeannette Medaris.

Robert was a graduate of the then Spencer High School prior to it becoming Owen Valley High School, and served in the United States Marine Corp. He spent his professional career with the General Motors Bus and Truck Division in Indianapolis. As an honorably discharged veteran he enjoyed his membership with the American Legion in Spencer and serving on the volunteer honor guard. He along with his wife Janet, had been members of the Smithville Christian Church before her death in 2009. In recent years he came to call Mt. Calvary Baptist Church his church home.
