Robert Michael Sutton, 84, of Bloomington, passed away Friday morning, July 5, at home surrounded by his family.

He was born November 17, 1928 in Chicago, Illinois to Robert Joseph Sutton and Frances M. Carberry. He attended St. Gregory High School and Loyola University, downtown campus, in Chicago. Robert was married to Louise (Frey) Sutton on September 19, 1953 at Our Lady of Grace Church in Chicago. Robert served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War.

Robert and his family moved to Bloomington in 1963 to work as a sales representative for Pfizer Agricultural Drugs. He retired from Pfizer after 33 years of service. He was a member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church and life member of the Knights of Columbus and past Grand Knight of Council #1096. He was a charter member of the Msgr. Thomas J. Kilfoil Assembly, 4th degree in Bloomington and District Deputy for Bloomington, Bedford, Seymour and Columbus Council, 1969-1972. He volunteered at Crisis Pregnancy Center and was involved with the St. Charles PTO, Intergenerational Program and Tri-parish retirees. Robert enjoyed playing racquetball,
