Robert W. Fowler of Bloomington passed away early Tuesday morning November 6, 2012 at Garden Villa, two days shy of his eighty third birthday, November 8, 1929. He was born in Greene County to William Alexander Fowler and Amanda Pryor Fowler.

Robert was a 1948 graduate of University high School; a veteran of the United States Air Force, and spent his working career as a farmer and a union pipe fitter in construction with U.A. Local #136.
