Roger W. Vaught, 80, of Bloomington went home to be with the Lord on Friday, February 12, 2021 at the IU Health Hospice House surrounded by his family.

He was born on August 13, 1940 in Bloomington, Indiana the son of Thomas Edward and Rosie Charlotte (Clark) Vaught. He attended Bloomington High School, and then finished his education in the U.S. Army. Roger was so proud to be a U.S. Army Veteran serving during the Vietnam War era. He worked for Indiana University for over 37 years as the ROTC Supply MPC Assistant retiring in 2000. He also worked when he was younger for the Bloomington Parks and Rec department for several years. He married Linda C. Prince on July 25, 1997 in Bloomington, Indiana.
