Bloomington- Ronald E. Wormley, 69, of Bloomington passed away unexpectedly at home Jan. 4, 2014.

Ron was born in Chicago, IL to Lyle and Dorothy (Wahlstrom) Wormley Taylor on Feb. 27, 1944. He graduated from Nineveh High School in 1963 and attended Purdue University as an aeronautics major. Ron was a veteran of the Vietnam War era serving in the US Air Force for four years as a jet engine mechanic. He then completed x-ray school at Methodist Hospital School for Radiologic Technologists and retired after many years as a radiologic technologist at Bloomington Hospital Promptcare Clinic.

Ron was a member of the Am-Vets Post 2000. He enjoyed fishing for many years of his life and also golf with his Am-Vets buddies. Ron was a 2 yr. survivor of throat cancer and had recently been given a clean bill of health by his oncologists. He enjoyed his time with family, grandchildren and friends.

Ron is survived by his wife of 41 years, Peggy Wormley of Bloomington, daughter Kelly Mullen (DJ) of Bloomington, son Kevin Wormley (Molly) of Tucson, AZ, brother Ken Wormley of Carolina

Beach, NC, sister Susan Taylor of Carson City, NV and grandchildren Tanner, Emma and Charles Ryder Mullen all of Bloomington and many cousins. He was preceded in death by his father, Lyle Wormley, his step-father, Walter Taylor and his mother Dorothy (Wormley) Taylor.
