



Ronald Harry Guy, Sr.

October 18, 1946 - February 21, 2019

Ronald Harry Guy, Sr., passed away on Thursday, February 21, 2019 at his residence. He was born on October 18, 1946 in Bowling Green, Kentucky; the son of Levi and Alva (Howell) Guy.

Ron joined the United States Marine Corps on June 9, 1964. Ron served during the Vietnam War, having received several notable medals. He was honorably discharged as a Sargent on June 9, 1968. Following his service, Ron joined with the Marine Corps Reserves until 1974. He went on to serve the United States Army, retiring with the rank of Major in 1995. During his extensive service career, Ron also worked for and retired with 30 years, within the United States Postal Service.

Ron was a former member of the Board of Directors, State Chairman, and District Chairman of Leader Dog. He was past president of Westside Lions Club, a member of the American Legion along with the Ceremonial Union National Guard and the Sagimore of the Wabash.

Ronald is survived by his sons, Ronald Guy, Jr. (Hannah) and Paul Guy; grandson, Cayden Guy; companion, Carolyn Endicott; and adoptive family, and his daughter, Ronda Roberts and children of Seattle WA.

He was preceded in death by both his parents, loving wife Elizabeth Guy, and

three step-sisters.

A funeral service will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, February 25, 2019 at Allen Funeral Home and Crematory, 4155 S. Old State Road 37, Bloomington. Burial will follow at Duncan Cemetery with full military honors. Family will receive friends from 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 24, 2019 at the funeral home. 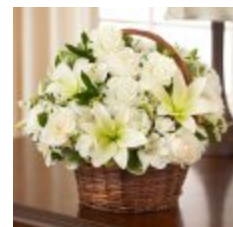

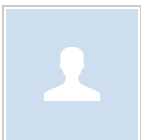
