Ronald Lee Potts, 72, of Bloomington, Indiana passed away on Monday, April 8, 2019 at Golden Living Center. He was born on October 4, 1946 in Lawrence County, Indiana, the son of Cecil Marion and Mary Louise (Dillon) Potts. Ronald attended Bedford High School in Lawrence County.
