June 21, 1924 - March 13, 2016

Ruby L. Hays, age 91 of Bloomington passed away Sunday morning March 13, 2016 at the Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. She was born in Bloomington to Henry Nunn and Bertha Phegley Nunn on June 21, 1924.

Ruby was in the 1941 graduating class of Bloomington High School, and spent over 30 years with RCA before retirement in 1981. She was an avid reader, loved to travel and do cross word puzzles but will be most fondly remembered as the loving and devoted wife, mother, and grandmother her family knew her as.

Ruby leaves behind her son Bernard Hays, Jr. and wife Doris of Indianapolis, daughter Donna Deckard and husband Royce, son Bruce Hays and wife Joyce, and son Paul "Pete" Hays and wife Linda, all of Bloomington. 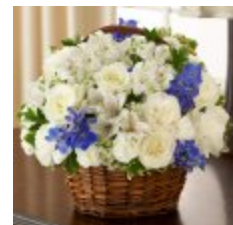
