Russell O. Chance, age 99, of Indianapolis died on Thursday, March 27, 2025, at his residence. He was born on March 1, 1926, in Logansport, IN, the son of John and Helen (Daywalt) Chance. He retired from the Indiana Bell Telephone Company and was a member of Lighthouse Baptist Church in Indianapolis. He was also a longtime little league coach in Bloomington. He coached baseball and basketball, but his most successful sport he coached was football, coaching the Pepsi Cola Eagles. Russell gave back to the community through his volunteer work at the local Boys Club. He served his country during World War II.

Survivors include his beloved wife, Joyce Chance; his sons, John (Martina) Chance, Harry M. (Kim) Chance, Thad A. (Karla) Chance, and Todd Chance; stepchildren, Tim (Kim) Foster and Teanna (late husband, Tim) Ring; grandchildren, Ashley, Courtney, Tommy; step-grandchildren, Jennifer, Branden, Jared, Dakota, and Keith; great grandchild, Cambryn; and step-great grandchildren, Kensey, Breanna, Matt, Ryne, and Eli. Russell was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife, Patricia A. Chance; and his daughter in law, Tammy Chance.

In life, Russell enjoyed grilling and gardening. He was known for being a handyman. Though Russell contributed so much to the community, his greatest achievement was leaving a legacy of what matters most; a fine

quality family to carry on in his honor.

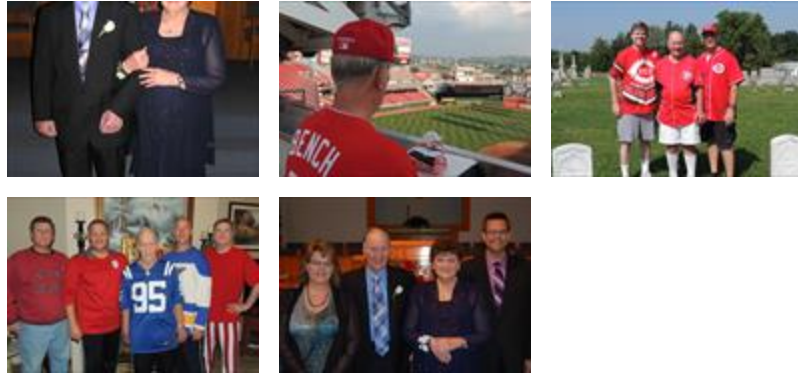

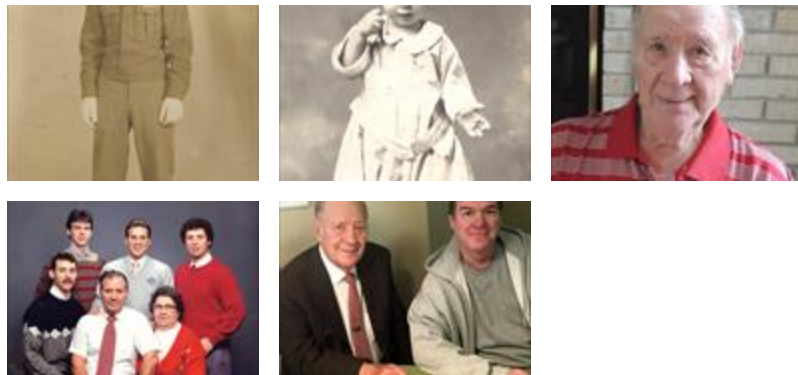
