Ruth I. Emch Gleason, 74, of Bloomington passed away Tuesday, October 25, 2022 at her residence. She was born January 28, 1948 in Toledo, Ohio, to Lawrence and Bessie (Short) Emch.

She was a member of St. Charles Catholic Church. There she served in numerous capacities and on numerous committees. Most importantly, she taught at St. Charles School for over 35 years. She managed the media center and library and she taught religion class to the eighth grade. She was also the founder and director of the Summer Institute, a summer enrichment program attended by hundreds of children each summer for almost 30 years.

She enjoyed studying history, gardening, reading, and spending time with her loved ones. Teaching was her passion and she cherished her students. So much did she love her students that many of them became family to her and she to them. She loved animals—especially cats—and volunteered with animals at Petco for the past several years.

She is survived by her daughter, Marie Gleason Staker, her brother, James Emch, her sister-in-law Teresa, and their children Paul and Kathy. She is also survived by countless students whom she adopted and loved as her own.

She was preceded in death by her parents.

Visitation will be at 10 a.m., Monday, October 31, 2022 at St. Charles Catholic Church, 2222 E. Third St, Bloomington.

A Mass of Christian Burial will follow at 11 a.m. at the church with Father Michael Keucher, one of her adopted sons, officiating. Internment will follow at a later time. All are welcome after the funeral Mass to a meal provided by the church in the Parish Hall.
