Ryan Faubion, 36, died May 3, 2012 at IU Health Hospital in Bloomington, IN surrounded by family and friends.

Born on September 10, 1975, in Greenfield, IN to Pam Strunk Caudill and Gene Faubion, Ryan grew up in Indianapolis, IN passionate about music, skateboarding, and design. His passion for creative pursuits led him to travel extensively and work in an array of creative and technical capacities throughout his life.
