May 25, 1946 - December 22, 2014

Sandra Sue McCormick, age 68 of Bloomington passed away Monday afternoon, December 22, 2014 at the Indiana University Health University Hospital in Indianapolis. Sandy was born May 25, 1946 in Connersville, Indiana to Isaac A. Fox and Sarah Lucy Lakes Fox.

She was a graduate of Connersville High School in 1964. Sandy went on to dedicate her professional career to the United States Department of Defense starting in Alameda, Oakland, and San Diego, California before moving to the Ft. Benjamin Harrison Finance Center in Indianapolis. From Indianapolis she moved to and ultimately retired from the Naval Surface Warfare Center in Crane, working in the personnel department there, from 1985 until 2001.
