Shirley Ann Calvert 73, of Spencer, passed away on Thursday, March 24, 2016 at McCormick's Creek Skilled Nursing & Rehab Center. She was born January 21, 1943 in Lake County Indiana to Mark S. Stone and Virginia R. (McDole) Stone. She was a lifelong resident of Bloomington.

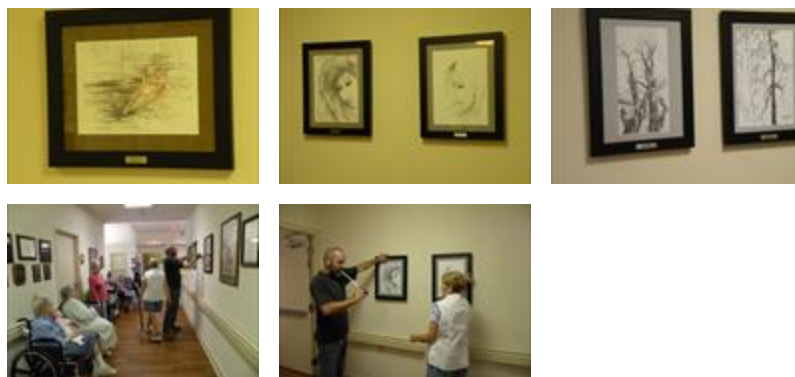
