Sondra Lee Woodhouse passed away peacefully on April 20th, 2025 (Easter Sunday) at Belle Trace Hospice in Bloomington, Indiana.

Sondra was born on August 17th, 1939, in Cleveland, Ohio. She was the third of four children born to Howard and Jayne Olson. Her eldest sibling was her brother Richard, her older sister was June Rae, and her younger sister was Karen. She graduated from Niles McKinley High School in June of 1957.
