Stephan (Steve) S. Woods, 52 of Bloomington passed away on March 29, 2018. Steve was born and raised in Shelbyville, Indiana and lived with his wife, Jodi and dog, Shadow in Bloomington, Indiana.

Steve was a sincere, spiritual, kind, funny, and intelligent man; loving husband; devoted son, brother and family member; and good friend to many. Steve loved music and was an immensely talented multi-instrumentalist (guitar, banjo, drums, harmonica, etc.) and vocalist. He was also a skilled music recording and production enthusiast.

mushrooms, grilling; model trains and model cars; going to concerts; watching old TV shows and movies, listening to records, reading and spending time with friends and family.
