Stephen H. Anderson, 67, passed away Wednesday morning, February 9, 2011 at Bloomington Hospital after a long and courageous battle with emphysema. Born January 1, 1944 in Vincennes, Indiana, Steve was the son of Paul J. Sr. and Virginia (Haynes) Anderson. Steve attended Vincennes High School and retired from Hoosier Energy after twenty five years as a Systems Control Engineer.

Steve loved anything outdoors from tent camping in the early years to many years of boating with his family and friends at Lake Monroe, year round. He became a passionate sailor taking Carolyn as his first mate on sailing trips, island hopping in the Caribbean. They also went on several cruises together in the later years.
