



## Susan Marie Ketcham Herbin

August 5, 1944 - May 8, 2020

On Friday, May 8th, Susan Marie Ketcham Herbin, amazing mother of five, passed away at the age of 75. She was born on August 5th, 1944 to Milton Eads (Jack) and Inez Pearl (Deckard) Ketcham. She graduated from Smithville High School, and later from Johns Hopkins University with a degree in Nursing. She practiced nursing in Bloomington off and on for 38 years while raising a house-full of kids.

Susan became a nurse because she wanted to help people. She took untold numbers of casseroles and her famous pecan pies to church members in need. She served as a Den Leader for rowdy Cub Scouts, and she spent years of her life at ball games, wrestling meets, band practice, and military recognitions. She took on the parents of schoolyard bullies, hospital administrators, and state legislators to fight for what she believed was right, but she was so softhearted that she once gave away her car to a family in need she barely knew.

She was preceded in death by her father, Jack, and her mother, Inez, and by a grandson, Jack. She is survived by her brothers, Mike and Dan; by her children Les, Tim, Pat, Susannah, and Thomas; and by nine other grandchildren.
