



## Thomas E. Stone

February 3, 1937 - February 13, 2014

Thomas E. Stone, age 76 of Springville, passed away at his residence early Thursday morning, February 13, 2014. He was born February 3, 1937 in Bloomington to Logan and Lillian McLain Stone.

Tom attended University School in Bloomington.

He enjoyed a wide variety of jobs throughout his life. At a very young age he set pins up at a local bowling alley. At Bloomington Packing company he learned his trade as a meat cutter. He worked as a butcher at Eisner's, Schneiders Meat Market and Hays market. He worked as a security guard at both Fourwinds and later in life at Meadoowood. He worked at Indiana vendors and ultimately worked at the Eagles Lodge as a janitor, Club Secretary, and Manager.
