Thomas Fredrick Garrett, 87, of Bloomington, passed away on Friday, November 25, 2016 at IU Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born on August 2, 1929 in Newark, Delaware as the son of Thomas M. and Marie (Titgen) Garrett.
